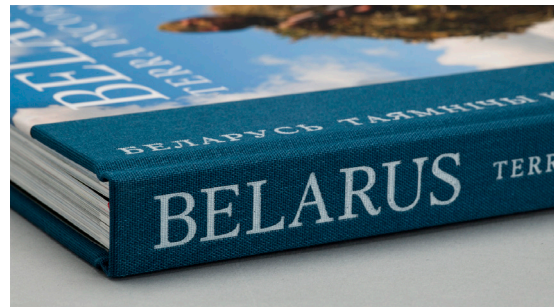
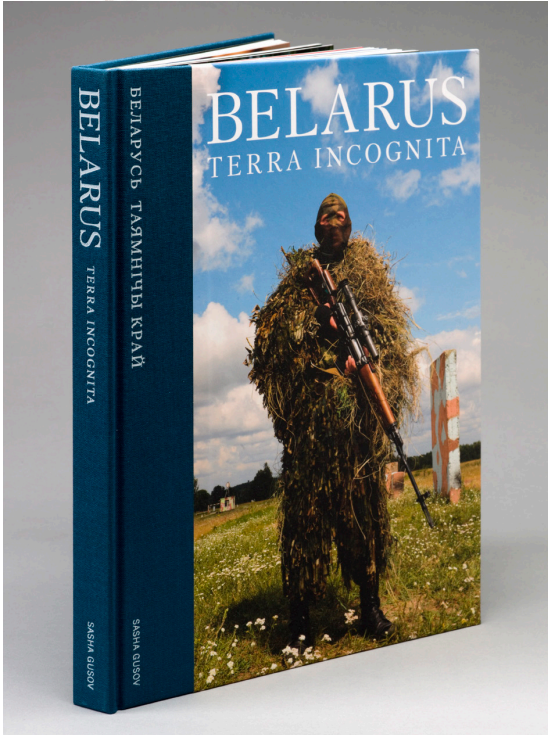




Hurtwood press case study
